Rethinking how supply chains should be designed to enhance their resiliency while still delivering on an organization's promises is a challenging task.

This seminar will help supply chain professionals understand the key characteristics of a resilient supply chain. It will also focus their attention on the financial implications of resilience and the potential for using an organization's financial capabilities to enhance the resilience of their supply chains. Supply chain professionals who attend this seminar series will take away a better understanding of what true supply chain resilience means, how to organize a supply chain to be resilient, and how financial mechanisms can be used to enhance resilience.
